Christ Jesus, the Way has as its theme the story of Jesus in the Temple (see Luke 2:41-49) which depicts the young Jesus “sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers.” This story shows that Jesus had studied the Hebrew Scriptures (our Old Testament) closely as a child. Level 6 children will look carefully at God’s action in human history as recorded in the Bible. The words of the Old and New Testament together offer the story of God’s people--a community of knowledge, love, and service.
